REACH Statement company Rosendahl

Dear customers,

the order for the regulation or registration of chemicals – in short **REACH** (**R**egistration – **E**valuation – **A**uthorization of **C**hemicals), has been approved from the European Parliament in 2007. For companies, the preregistration of substances ran out by the end of 2008.

A REACH team has been established within the company, that looked into the subject and accurately evaluated all possibly concerned substances in order to guarantee a smooth operation to our customers. It has been determined that the so-called „Phase in substances“ (already existing substances), and in this case especially monomer's with a tonnage of more than 1 ton per year, are being preregistered in order to comply with the REACH regulation.

From all other from the REACH regulation concerned substances the company Rosendahl buys less than a ton per year or the substances are purchased from within EU countries. In this case the REACH regulation requires the suppliers to distribute a confirmation of the substance's registration.

Classification, labelling and packaging (CLP) of substances within the supply chain is being maintained by Rosendahl.

Substances of very high concern (SVHC) are not being employed by the company Rosendahl!

Furthermore, the supplier is requested to always deliver the safety data sheets. At the latest at every delivery.
